Archaeological sites as rare and as ancient as the Hope Downs rock shelter must not be destroyed by mining (report, 10/4). This key site must be preserved because of the spiritual and emotional significance it will increasingly have for Pilbara indigenous communities.

The preserved deposit can be re-investigated in the future when excavation methods and, without doubt, radiometric dating techniques will be improved over those of the present day.
