

RCR Tomlinson wins \$60m Woodside contract

Engineering company RCR Tomlinson has won a \$60 million contract for work on Woodside Petroleum's Pluto LNG Project over two years, the company has announced.

The contract, for mechanical works and warehouse services, will be carried out by RCR's joint venture with Fremantle-based services company Freo Machinery, RCRFM Services.

RCR said in an announcement the contract win took the value of its order book to \$240 million, a record for the company.

Work on the project is due to begin in November this year, to continue to December 2010.

RCR shares were up 4 cents or 5.4 per cent to 78 cents at 10.24am.
