

Honeywell to secure Pluto

HONEYWELL has landed a contract to provide Woodside Energy's Pluto liquefied natural gas project with an industrial security system.

Based on Honeywell's Enterprise Buildings Integrator security management platform, the system will provide Woodside with convenient monitoring and single-window control of all access control, intrusion detection and video surveillance sub-systems.

Honeywell will design, engineer, test and stage the system, which is scheduled for completion in December 2008.

In January the company was awarded the contract to provide its Experion Process Knowledge System R300 integrated control system for Pluto.

Pluto will have sub-sea wells; an offshore, unmanned wellhead platform; a 180-kilometre trunk line; an onshore LNG plant; and associated infrastructure located near Karratha.

When commissioned in late 2010, Pluto is expected to produce 4.3 million tonnes of LNG per year.
