**Question & Answer:**

With regard to the land areas of the Burrup Peninsula and statements contained within the Burrup Peninsula Proposed Conservation Reserve Draft Management Plan, and this subsequent redirection of the question as advised in answer to question on notice 3932 of Tuesday 26 September 2006, I ask -

- (1) What is the area of the freehold title land in square kilometres of the Burrup Peninsula land to be transferred to the Aboriginal Approved Body Corporate, as defined in the Burrup and Maitland Industrial Estates Agreement Implementation Deed?
- (2) What is the area of the industrial lands in square kilometres on the Burrup Peninsula, excluding the adjoining islands and Maitland Industrial Estate outlined in the Burrup and Maitland Industrial Estates Agreement Implementation Deed?
- (3) What is the area of the industrial lands in square kilometres outlined in the Burrup and Maitland Industrial Estates Agreement Implementation Deed?
- (4) What is the area of the industrial lands on the Burrup Peninsula in square kilometres, and as a percentage of the total land zoned industrial in the Shire of Roebourne Scheme No. 8 Town Planning Scheme?
- (5) Is the land area of the Burrup Peninsula an area of approximately 118 square kilometres as defined by the Department of Land Information?
- (6) If no to (5), what is the land area of the Burrup Peninsula?

Department of Industry and Resources advises:

- (1) Approximately 49 sq km.
- (2) Approximately 12 sq km.
- (3) Approximately 109 sq km.
- (4) Approximately 32 sq km (including the 12 sq km above). Another approximately 7 sq km is reserved for industrial corridors. The Hon Member needs to ask the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure to find out the total area of land zoned industrial in the Shire of Roebourne Scheme No 8 Town Planning Scheme. The Shire of Roebourne is unable to supply the information.
- (5) The Hon Member needs to ask the Minister for Land Information. More information is required by the Department of Land Information on what map area is being defined as the Burrup Peninsula to answer this question.
- (6) Approximately 92 sq km defined as the study area of the Burrup Peninsula Land Use Plan and Management Strategy 1996 [BPLUPMS - see tabled paper no.]. Note that land area estimates have changed since the BPLUPMS due to different current mapping techniques. Furthermore, the BPLUPMS areas did not take into account land required for industrial corridors.

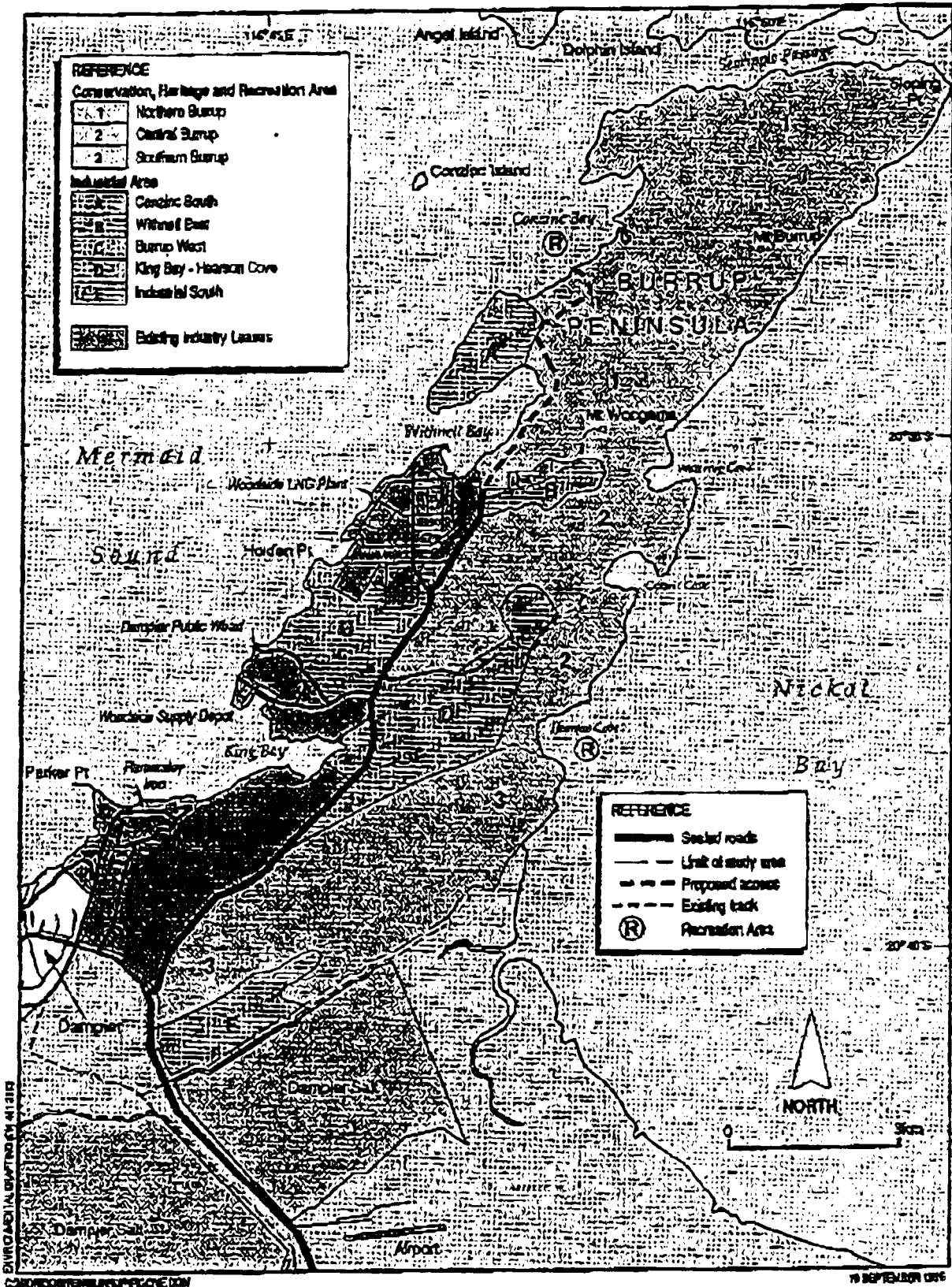


Figure 2: BURRUP PENINSULA LAND USE PLAN
