The Minister for Aboriginal Affairs Michelle Roberts is quoted in *The West Australian* newspaper on 28 February 2007, stating that there were 'no commercially viable alternative sites' available for Woodside's proposed Pluto LNG plant on the Burrup Peninsula, and I ask -

(1) Can the Minister inform the Parliament whether DOIR or any other Government department has carried out a relative cost and heritage risk assessment for alternative sites for the Pluto LNG plant, which would have little or no impact on WA's unique Aboriginal cultural heritage?
